This program leads to Emissions Inspector Certification by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation. It contains 16 hours of classroom instruction, which includes demonstrations on Dynamometer gas analyzing and OBDII equipment, written examination, and computer-based test (CBT). Test results will be forwarded to PARSONS, contractor of Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, for grading. **You cannot perform emissions inspections without this card.**

Inspector Certification is valid for two (2) years. You will then be required to take a Recertification course to maintain your certification. Please contact Dauphin County Technical School for Recertification course information.
